

REGULATION

1. DATE AND PLACE:

Technical Officials nomination deadline	09 June 2016

2. PARTICIPANTS

The participation in the European Under 15&17 Weightlifting Championships is limited to athletes (men and women) and team officials from National Federations which are members of the EWF.

3. COMPETITION AND TRAINING VENUE:

Competition Venue - Mlodziezowe Centrum Podnoszenia Ciezarow (Weightlifting Youth Center), 37 Polnoc Street, Nowy Tomysl – Poland,

Training Venue – 1 Sczanieckiej Street, Nowy Tomysl

Warming-up area - 11 platforms, Training area - 15 platforms.

Shuttle buses will provide transportation between hotels, training hall and competition hall at any time.

4. CATEGORIES and AGE LIMITATIONS

Under 15 European Weightlifting Championships

Age Category:	Between thirteen (13) and fifteen (15) years of age (boys and girls).
Girls, 7 categories:	- 44 kg, 48 kg, 53 kg, 58 kg, 63 kg, 69 kg, +69 kg
Boys, 8 categories:	- 50 kg, 56 kg, 62 kg, 69 kg, 77 kg, 85 kg, 94 kg, +94 kg,

Under 17 European Weightlifting Championships

Age Category:	Between thirteen (13) and seventeen (17) years of age (boys and girls).
Girls, 7 categories:	- 44 kg, 48 kg, 53 kg, 58 kg, 63 kg, 69 kg, +69 kg
Boys, 8 categories:	- 50 kg, 56 kg, 62 kg, 69 kg, 77 kg, 85 kg, 94 kg, +94 kg,

One federation competes with two different teams in U15 and U17 competitions. U15 and U17 need different weightlifters. The same lifter can't compete in two competitions and can't be classified in two competitions.





5. EQUIPMENT

WERK-SAN (approved by IWF) equipment (men and women) will be used for the competitions.

6. DOPING CONTROL

Doping Control will be conducted in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Policy.

7. COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Championships will be held according to IWF Technical Rules and EWF Constitution.

8. ACCOMMODATION

All athletes and team members will be fully accommodated in Hotels in Nowy Tomysl, Grodzisk and Wolsztyn – about 20 min. to competition hall.

EWF Technical Officials will be accommodated in the Atrium Hotel in Nowy Tomysl. All payments must be transferred until August 17th to the account number of the bank as indicated below. The minimum stay in the hotel for the participants in the competition is three (3) nights.

9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place in the Accreditation Center in the Sports Hall - Mlodziezowe Centrum Podnoszenia Ciezarow (Weightlifting Youth Center), 37 Polnoc Street, Nowy Tomysl – Poland,

10. FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Each national federation is kindly requested to bring 2 (two) National Flags (100 x 150 cm) and the national anthem in the mp3 format. The Organizing Committee will collect them upon arrival from each delegation.

11. TRANSPORTATION

Transportation between the Poznan-Lawica Airport– hotels in Nowy Tomysl – Airport Poznan-Lawica will cost 20 Euro/person. The Organizing Committee will provide shuttle bus service between the place of accommodation and competition, training and meetings venue.

12. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Participation fee (includes costs of accommodation and meals):
Single room: 115 Euro per person / per night / full board
Double room: 95 Euro per person / per night / full board
Triple room: 90 Euro per person / per night / full board

Transportation between Airport – hotels – Airport will cost 20 Euro/person.

Entry fee: 150 Euro per person.

The highest six (6) ranked federations (boys and girls, U15 & U17) will receive team awards. All participants will receive diplomas and a special gift.

15. VISAS

All participants must check if a visa is required for their entry to Poland. Should visa be required, participants will have to apply for the visa in the Polish Embassy/ Consulate in their home country. If assistance is needed, please contact the Organizers.

16. INSURANCE

All Member Federations have to provide travel and accident insurance of all their participants before leaving their country in accordance with EWF regulations.
