### 2. ACCOMMODATION AND ENTRY FEE

### AIRPORT HOTEL OKECIE, RASZYN, POLAND

Check-in time: 03.00 pm Check-out time:12.00 am

The minimum stay in the hotel for the participants in the competition is four (4) nights.

### Hotel "No-Show" charges:

If one or more members of a delegation fail to check into their accommodation on the date specified on the Accommodation and Transportation Form, and also fail to notify the LOC at least 10 days before the first competition day, the delegation is to pay the "no-show" fee for every person who failed to arrive. The charge is equal to the Accommodation Fee per person/per day (for all days specified in the Accommodation and Transportation Form)

If one or more participants are delayed one or more days, the delegation must pay for all the days specified in the Accommodation and Transportation Form submitted.

After the submission of the Accommodation and Transportation form on the 26th of September 2024, should you require any additional hotel rooms, the LOC will try their best to accommodate your additional team members at the same hotel, however, this cannot be guaranteed.

Cancellations will not be accepted after 17th October 2024.

The accommodation fees and entry fees are:

Single Occupancy 160 € (Euros) per person per day Double Occupancy 140 € (Euros) per person per day Triple Occupancy 120 € (Euros) per person per day

EWF Entry Fee - 200 € (Euros) per person

In addition, 100 \$ (USD) for IWF Special Anti-Doping Fee, which will be paid only by athletes who will compete in the European Junior Championship.

### **Transportation Fee: 30 € (Euros)** per person.

All the incidental extra costs will be covered by the guests staying in the room, including in-room movies, long-distance telephone charges, room service, resort fees, and other such services.







Participants must pay for incidentals at the front desk at their own expense.

\*No cooking devices will be permitted in any areas of the hotels.

### 6. AGE LIMITATIONS, CATEGORIES AND ELIGIBILITY

### **EUROPEAN JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- **Age category** - Athletes born between January 1st, 2004 and December 31st, 2009 (aged between 15 and 20) are eligible to participate in the Junior Championships.







**Women, 10 bodyweight categories**: 45kg, 49kg, 55kg, 59kg, 64kg, 71kg, 76kg, 81kg, 87kg, +87kg. **Men, 10 bodyweight categories**: 55kg, 61kg, 67kg, 73kg, 81kg, 89kg, 96kg, 102kg, 109kg, +109kg.

### **EUROPEAN UNDER 23 CHAMPIONSHIPS**

- **Age category** - Athletes born between January 1st, 2001, and December 31st, 2003 (aged 21, 22, and 23) are eligible to participate in the Under 23 Championships.

**Women, 10 bodyweight categories**: 45kg, 49kg, 55kg, 59kg, 64kg, 71kg, 76kg, 81kg, 87kg, +87kg. **Men, 10 bodyweight categories**: 55kg, 61kg, 67kg, 73kg, 81kg, 89kg, 96kg, 102kg, 109kg, +109kg.

### 7. ELIGIBILITY

Participation in the European Junior and U23 Championships is limited to weightlifters and team officials from the National Federation which are full members of the EWF.

In accordance with Article 5.5.16 of the 2023 IWF Anti-Doping Rules, the Whereabouts information of the weightlifters participating in the European Junior Championships shall be submitted at a minimum of three months prior to the Event (by 26th July 2024).

All athletes participating are recommended to complete the WADA ADeL online course for athletes before competing. The following link will take you to the course: <a href="https://adel.wada-ama.org/">https://adel.wada-ama.org/</a>

Athletes and support personnel (coaches, team physicians) must register on the site, watch the videos, and pass the quiz at the end to earn a certificate, much as they did with the IWF ILiftClean platform. Please contact WADA at <a href="mailto:adel@wada-ama.org">adel@wada-ama.org</a> if athletes and athlete support personnel (coaches, team doctors, etc.) have any issues with the registration procedure.

### 8. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be carried out by ITA on behalf of IWF by an appointed sample collection authority in accordance with the IWF Anti-Doping Rules.

### 9. INSURANCE

Participating Federations must accept full moral and financial responsibility for their respective delegations.

Before departing their homeland, all participants must be covered by their respective Federations for travel and accident/injury/illness.







### 10. COMPETITION RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Championships will be held according to the current IWF Technical Competition Rules and Regulations (IWF TCRR) and EWF Constitution.

IWF Certified Weightlifting Equipment will be used.

### 11. AWARDS

Gold, Silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second, and third-place lifters in Snatch, Clean & Jerk, and Total in each bodyweight category for each championship.

The best male and female athletes, as well as the top six ranked men's and women's teams, will receive trophies according to the IWF team classification.

Diplomas will be awarded to all participants.

## 12. VISAS

Participants who require a visa to enter Poland must submit a request to the Poland Weightlifting Federation together with passport copies before 26. August 2024 to the email address: biuro@pzpc.pl

### 13. FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Each National Federation is kindly requested to bring two (2) National Flags ( $100 \times 150 \text{ cm}$ ) and the national anthem in "mp3" format.

The Local Organizing Committee will collect them upon arrival from each delegation.

### 14. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

Accredited Participants – athletes, team officials, technical officials (ITO), media, guests, etc. must:

- Acknowledge and fully comply with the EWF, the IWF Constitution and By-Laws, the IWF TCRR, the Anti-Doping Rules (ADR)
- Abide by all reasonable directions given by the EWF, the Organizing Committee (OC),







TOs

- Should accept any prize or award given by EWF and /or OC/sponsors, and will attend all special award ceremonies where prizes or awards are presented
- Should attend Press Conference upon request of EWF/OC
- Should not participate in, support, or promote illegal betting
- Should be responsible for all property they bring into the Event the EWF and/ or OC shall have no responsibility for any loss or damage to this property
- Should irrevocably release EWF & OC from liability for any loss, injury, or damage that they may suffer in relation to their participation in the Event
- Should guarantee that they participate in the Event with the permission of their parent(s) or guardian(s) in case they are minors
- Should acknowledge that by not following the above-mentioned terms and conditions, sanctions may be imposed
- Agree that entry is subject to payment of all fees inclusive of entry, Anti-Doping, accommodation, food, and transportation payment prior to use of any OC or EWF facility, or for airport transfers
- Should acknowledge that no accommodation or arrangement is guaranteed until full payment is received in advance
- All participating Federations should undertake full moral and financial responsibility
  of their registered/accredited delegates with regard to their health and wellness, and
  in the case of accidents or damages not attributable to the OC.
- All participating federations and their members agree that any material recorded during the competition in which they are located may be used for EVF promotional purposes without compensation.

### **15. MEDIA**

All media participants must be approved in advance. No Accreditation fee is required. Media Accreditation requests shall be submitted via e-mail to the Poland Weightlifting Federation and EWF.

The EWF and Poland Weightlifting Federation pay special attention to Media representatives interested in the most important EWF continental competition and weightlifting, in general. In this sense, the Organizing Committee is considering extending the possibility of overnight accommodation in other hotels with more advantageous financial conditions for accredited Media Representatives.
